Encore Theater Group New Musicals Reading Series at the Litehouse

Litehouse Development Group has teamed with the Encore Theater Company providing the Downtown Dayton town home as a venue for their New Musicals Reading Series. During these sessions local actors perform readings of original material submitted by playwrights from across the country. The readings are taped and provided to the playwrights who, in many cases, will hear their material read for the first time.

Encore Theater Company was launched in 1999 with the purpose of participating in the development of new American musicals by working with creative teams from all over the country. The original musical, Despairadise, was the first musical of the New Musicals Reading Series at the Litehouse.
